## A new record of spider species from Tunisia (Arachnida: Araneae)

### Abstract

In order to increase our arachnological knowledge of Tunisia, an updated annotated checklist was provided; this contribution is the continuity of the Bosmans's checklist initiated in 2003 to improve taxonomic and faunistic insights on spiders in Tunisia.

The number of species increased from the last checklist from 355 to 410 species. The majority of species belongs to the families Gnaphosidae (45 species), Salticidae (44 species), Theridiidae (44 species), Linyphiidae (38 species), Araneidae (31 species), Lycosidae (30 species) and Thomisidae (26 species).

### 1. Introduction

The Mediterranean Basin is referred as one of the world most important biodiversity hotspot (Myers et al., 2000). Spiders are amongst the most diverse orders worldwide; they belong to the largest order Araneae of the Class Arachnida of the Phylum Arthropoda. Spiders count for 44906 described species, 3935 genera grouped in 114 families (Platnick, 2014). Owing to their great ability to hide in a variety of habitats except true aquatic in nature, it is believed that about 200,000 species exist. In spite of this, spiders' diversity is poorly known and insufficiently investigated in the Western Mediterranean ecosystems.

In the Mediterranean region spider taxonomy has been far less thoroughly considered and revised than in central and northern European countries, mainly owing to a lack of continuous research (Thaler, 2000).

By virtue of its geological history and geographical location, Tunisia constitutes a refuge for a disproportionately high diversity of organisms; however, spiders' diversity in Tunisia remains insufficiently studied and a lot of new species are waiting to be described.

The most recent checklist of spiders in Tunisia dates back thirteen years (Bosmans, 2003), 355 species were recorded, in which forty species were endemic from

Tunisia. Since the publication of the previous checklist of spider species, some new records and additional collecting has been undertaken.

The aim of this paper is to update Tunisian checklist based on original collected samples and literature records. Original materials, collected by the author in various expeditions throughout the country, will be published in successive papers. The following checklist will hopefully be useful for environmental management and planning, as well as a starting point for further biological studies of the regional spider fauna.

### 2. Material and methods

The present checklist is based on the critical incorporation of all available published records on the distribution of spiders in Tunisia since Bsmans' checklist record in 2003 and also based on field sampling undertaken from 2010 to 2015.

Spiders were sampled by hand (plant and ground search, turning rocks, and sifting of leaf litter) or using a sweepnet or beating tray for grass and low shrubs. The spiders caught were brought to the laboratory in vials having 90-95% alcohol and labeled after identification. The specimens were thoroughly examined under Stereoscope dissecting microscope.

The identification was made with the help of keys and description given in books and other relevant literature. The classification of the collected material was carried out on the basis of external morphological characters which included arrangement of eyes, leg posture and numbers of tarsal claws. Beside their habitats, behavior also provided a clue. Voucher specimens are housed in the laboratory of genetic and enhancement of bioressources, high institute of biotechnology of Monastir, Tunisia

For each species, it is indicated in which Tunisian province it has been cited.

The new checklist provides an updated list of species names, including recent taxonomic name changes for some species. The order of the families, the assignment of genera to the respective family, the names of the species and distributions are listed according to the latest World Spider Catalogue (Platnick, 2014).

Worldwide species distribution was evaluated according to the one cited in the World Spider Catalogue (Platnick 2014). We considered:

(a) Tun: Tunisian endemics as the ones only cited from Tunisia. Species occurring outside this range were classified as:

(b) Mag: Species known from the Maghreb countries (Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia and Libya); (c) Afr; N Afr; NW Afr; NC Afr: Known from Africa, or from the Maghreb countries and Egypt; or from North and West Africa; (d) Med and W Med: Known from the entire or only the Western part of the Mediterranean; (e) N Afr As: Known from North Africa and Asia; (f) Med As: known from the mediterranean region and Asia; (g) Pal: Known from Palearctic regions; (h) O Wor: Old World, if extending towards sub-Saharan Africa; (i) Hol: Holarctic, if present in both the Palearctic and the Nearctic; (j) Cos: Cosmopolitan, if present in almost every region of the world, usually associated with human habitats and (k) Other countries: in the single case where the species distribution did not follow the previously mentioned.

### 3. Results

At present, 410 species of spiders have been recorded from Tunisia. The most importnt Tunisian families are Gnaphosidae (45 species), Salticidae (44 species), Theridiidae (44 species), Linyphiidae (38 species), Araneidae (31 species), Lycosidae (30 species) and Thomisidae (26 species).

Common Tunisian spiders are *Argiope trifasciata* (known from 15 provinces), *Steatoda paykulliana* (known from 11 provinces), *Thomisus onustus*,

*Euroephrys gambosa* and *Cyrtophora cytricola* (known from 10 provinces), they appear to be the most frequently collected ones (see Table 1).

### 4. Discussion

Since Bosmans record (Bosmans, 2003), the number of spider species has increased from 355 to 410.

The current knowledge of Tunisian spiders is severely incomplete. New species have been described from Tunisia (e.g. Bosmans, 2003, Ribera and Planas, 2009) and many other species remain to be discovered, part of these are still undescribed.

They are a numerous of reasons that may explain the lack of knowledge of the Tunisian spiders' diversity: (i) as the case of all North African countries, arachnology is a neglected science; (ii) there are no experts in the taxonomy of spiders in Tunisia; (iii) moreover, public awareness and political interest on spiders are nonexistent in Tunisia.

A better knowledge on population genetics of this species is necessary in order to management of the increasing commercial exploitation of this species. Additional sampling will be needed to confirm the above finding and to contribute in conservation plans for its protection. Moreover, Research on the patterns of marine population structure in this area, using nuclear genes would reinforce this finding.

### 4. Conclusion

As the ecology and diversity of the spider fauna of Tunisia are so poorly known, each study becomes an important contribution to our knowledge on the geographical distribution of spider species.

Only with an updated checklist (listing of species) and catalogue (distribution of species) would make it is possible to know what was already made and what gaps remain to be filled. For future investigations, it is necessary to apply standardized and optimized sampling protocols.
